Call for artists:

The Haybale Gallery is seeking artists for an experimental, one-time, time-sensitive, pop-up art exhibition.

Artists will be free to exhibit artwork in any media or performance for a 30-minute lightning-exhibition at one of several locations in the East Bay on Monday, February 5th, 2018. These locations will range from public parks, to parking lots, to galleries. Locations will be at a range of public and private spaces, both officially sanctioned and by fiat, in dialogue with the artists.

The Haybale Gallery will provide artists with a bale of hay, measuring 6' wide, 6' deep, and 8.5' tall, as a location to display or anchor artworks/performances, as the artist(s) see fit.

The full run of the exhibition will be documented and collected in a limited-run exhibition catalog, produced in the style and spirit of the show as a whole and will be available for purchase.

Exhibition details:

- Date: Monday, 05 February, 2018
- Time: Artists will be given specific 30-minute periods in the course of the day during which to exhibit their work.
- Location: Each exhibit will be at a different location in the East Bay, in and around Oakland, CA.
- Restrictions: Artists are free to perform or display artwork in any media or style that does not destroy or compromise the provided cube, so that it may be taken apart and transported at the end of the exhibition time to the next site.
- Submissions: Submissions by email, to: thehaybalegallery@gmail.com
- Deadline: Proposals should be submitted by 29 January, 2018, and will be considered on a rolling basis until all spaces are filled. Late submissions will still be considered, but priority will be given to those received before 29 January.
- Fee: Submissions are free of cost. 100% of proceeds from sales will go to the artist(s).
